## *Detailed Fiscal Analysis*

If it chooses to do so, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) would incur negligible costs to install and maintain suitable markers, such as plaques or signs, on or near the bridge on State Route 108 that spans the Maumee River, in the city of Napoleon. According to ODOT, the current cost to manufacture, install, and maintain a single set of memorial plaques or signs at one location is a few hundred dollars, depending on the size of the signs. If ODOT chose not to install markers, then the city of Napoleon would have the option of doing so, and it would incur similar costs for installation and upkeep.
