Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill encourages certain retail establishments to allow customers with eligible medical conditions to use the retail establishment's restrooms that are not normally available to the public. The bill also grants retail establishments or their employees immunity against civil actions for injuries or deaths of customers permitted to use the employee conveniences, so long as there is no willful or gross negligence involved. The bill also designates May 23rd as Crohn's and Colitis Awareness Day. Because the bill requires no action on the part of the state or any political subdivisions, there is no direct fiscal effect.
