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Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill directs the General Assembly to establish a Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) school system to do the following: (1) create public schools that graduate students who have the knowledge and skills to live and work in the 21st Century global economy, (2) generate a talent base that will establish Ohio as a magnet and global leader in attracting, educating, and producing professionals needed to create innovations for the betterment of all citizens, and (3) foster increases in the number of Ohio citizens studying and working in STEM fields.

The state and local governments would experience no direct costs as a result of this bill, as the bill currently requires no actions to be taken by state agencies or political subdivisions.
