Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill designates October 22nd as "U.S.S. Hocking Day." The bill does not require any action by the state or its political subdivisions, thus there would be no new costs. If the designation were added to brochures or other printed matter, for example, it would be done when existing supplies are replenished. If the state or local governments chose to observe this day with commemorative events, those costs would entirely be permissive.
