
Detailed Fiscal Analysis

Overview

The bill limits the term of office for members of the Parole Board, other than a victim representative, to two six-year terms. A member is not eligible for reappointment after serving two six-year terms whether or not served consecutively.

State fiscal effects

Department of Rehabilitation and Correction. The Ohio Parole Board, which currently consists of seven members, is supported and financed by the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction. Based largely on discussions with departmental staff, it appears that the bill will not have any immediate effect on the state expenditures. In future years, however, when the bill would begin to end the tenure of affected Board members, newer presumably younger members would be appointed to the Board. To the extent that these newer members are younger and less experienced, they would likely be paid less than the Board members they replaced. Thus, the bill may result in future reductions in the payroll for Board members. The precise magnitude of any such future annual savings is uncertain.

Local fiscal effects

The bill will not directly affect the revenues and expenditures of the state's political subdivisions.
