### Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill will have no direct fiscal effect on any state agency or political subdivision. It requires the court in a hearing to permit a pregnant minor to consent to an abortion, or by which a court may give judicial consent to an abortion, to make specific inquiries of the minor and make certain findings by clear and convincing evidence. These are additional duties that would be performed during a hearing that is already required under current Ohio law and are not expected to generate any discernible costs for the court to comply.
