### Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill designates the month of September as "Mesothelioma Month" to bring attention to mesothelioma, and designates the month of November as "Lung Cancer Awareness Month" to bring attention to lung cancer. The bill requires no direct action on the part of local or state governmental entities. Thus, there will be no direct fiscal impact associated with these designations.
