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### Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill designates the month of May as "ALS Awareness Month" to increase public awareness and understanding of amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), a disease that is commonly known as Lou Gehrig's disease, and to encourage efforts in finding treatments and a cure. The bill requires no direct action on the part of the state or local governmental entities. Thus, there will be no direct fiscal impact.

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
