**Contents:** Specifies the manner of sending a notice of intent to file a medical claim and provides a procedure for the discovery of other potential defendants after the filing of a medical claim

### State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on the state.

### Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

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### Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill specifies that a claimant who allegedly possesses a medical claim is required to send a written notification to the subject of that claim by mail. The bill also provides a procedure for the discovery of other potential defendants within a specified period after the filing of a medical claim. The bill requires no direct action on the part of state or local governmental entities. Thus, there should be no direct fiscal costs associated with either the written notification or the procedure for discovery of other potential defendants.

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
