Contents: Requires university boards of trustees to deny or grant voting powers to student members

State Fiscal Highlights

- Adoption of the resolution required by the bill will not have a significant fiscal impact on state universities.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill requires the boards of trustees of Ohio's 14 state-assisted universities to adopt, within 90 days of the bill's effective date, a resolution denying or granting voting power to student trustees. Adoption of the resolution required by the bill will not have a significant fiscal impact on state universities as it should be possible to accomplish within the regular duties of the boards.

Synopsis of Fiscal Effect Changes

The substitute bill requires the Boards to adopt a resolution, whereas the As Introduced bill granted student trustees voting rights without requiring the adoption of a resolution. Neither version of the bill has a significant fiscal effect.
