Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill alters the designation of special parking locations for persons who have a disability that limits or impairs the ability to walk by designating such locations as "accessible parking spaces" rather than "handicapped parking spaces." The bill does not require state or local governments to replace signs in any parking lots or spaces operated by the government before the normal replacement schedule. As a result, the bill should not have any fiscal impact on state or local governments.
