State Fiscal Highlights

- Potential loss of license fee revenue if some individuals licensed by the State Board of Orthotics, Prosthetics, and Pedorthics no longer seek licensure as a result of the bill. License fee revenue collected by the Board is deposited in the Occupational Licensing and Regulatory Fund (Fund 4K90).

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill exempts diabetic shoe fitters who complete specified training from the requirement to be licensed by the State Board of Orthotics, Prosthetics, and Pedorthics. There could be a loss of license fee revenue if some individuals licensed by the State Board of Orthotics, Prosthetics, and Pedorthics no longer seek licensure as a result of the bill. License fee revenue collected by the State Board of Orthotics, Prosthetics, and Pedorthics is deposited in the Occupational Licensing and Regulatory Fund (Fund 4K90).

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
