### Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill adds pharmacists to the professional license exception to the Orthotist, Prosthetist, and Pedorthist Licensing Law. The bill most likely has no direct fiscal effect on the state. However, there could be a minimal loss of license fee revenue if there is a pharmacist currently licensed by both the State Board of Pharmacy and the State Board of Orthotics, Prosthetics, and Pedorthics who would no longer seek licensure as an orthotist, prosthetist, or pedorthist as a result of the bill.
