Detailed Fiscal Analysis

S.B. 58 specifies that it is the General Assembly's intent to review and possibly modify the energy efficiency, peak demand reduction, and alternative energy resource provisions established in the competitive retail electric service law enacted in Am. Sub. S.B. 221 of the 127th General Assembly.

The bill requires the review to consider various aspects of energy efficiency and peak demand reduction requirements and alternative energy resource requirements established in S.B. 221 given "changes in electric service occurring since 2008," and these changes are specifically defined in the bill.

Fiscal Effect

The provisions in the bill do not have a direct fiscal effect on either the state or local authorities.

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
