Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill establishes GRF appropriation item 235517, Columbus State Logistics Program, with an appropriation of \$2.5 million in both FY 2014 and FY 2015, to support workforce development initiatives through the Columbus State Community College Logistics Program. According to Columbus State's website, this program "provides training tailored to meet the workforce needs of businesses at entry to mid-level positions within warehouse, distribution, and related logistics positions."
