Contents: Designates a portion of State Route 309 in Allen County as the "Captain Dennis Pintor Memorial Highway"

State Fiscal Highlights

- The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) could incur costs of approximately \$350 to \$400 per sign if it supplies memorial marker signs to the village of Elida. However, the village would be charged for the costs of the signs.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- The village of Elida could incur signage costs of \$350 to \$400 per sign for installing the memorial markers along the designated highway.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill designates a portion of State Route 309 within the village of Elida as the "Captain Dennis Pintor Memorial Highway." According to guidance in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) Traffic Engineering Manual concerning memorial signage along U.S. and state routes inside municipal corporations, ODOT may supply memorial marker signs to a municipal corporation for a fee. However, the municipal corporation would be responsible for installation. According to ODOT, memorial markers cost approximately \$350 to \$400 per sign, including materials and labor. Once a set of markers is installed, typically there are no ongoing maintenance costs unless the signs are knocked down or damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
