



*Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

Sub. H.B. 344

124th General Assembly
(S. Insurance, Commerce, and Labor)

Prohibits the operation of a historical boiler in public unless the historical boiler bears a current, valid certificate of operation and is operated by an operator licensed under the bill.

Creates a seven-member Historical Boiler Licensing Board and specifies the Board's duties.

Establishes licensing requirements for operators of historical boilers that are operated in public.

Establishes inspection requirements and procedures for obtaining a certificate of operation for historical boilers that are operated in public.

Eliminates the House version requirement that the Board of Building Standards establish standards and compliance determination methods for the operation of tractors that are powered by historical boilers and used for hobby or demonstration.

Retains instead of eliminates, as did the House version, the existing exemption of historical boilers used for hobby or demonstration from the inspection requirements of the Boiler Inspection Law (R.C. Chapter 4104.).
