### **Am. H.B. 384**

124th General Assembly  
(S. Education)

Specifies that the requirement to have an employee trained in the performance of the Heimlich maneuver present during food service periods does not create a new cause of action or substantive legal right against any person.

Grants nonpublic schools and their employees qualified immunity from liability in connection with the requirement to have an appropriately trained person present when serving food to students.
