



*Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

The Committee adopted amendments that did the following:

Created the Brown County Municipal Court on February 9, 2003, and the Morrow County Municipal Court on January 1, 2003, and abolished, effective February 9, 2003, the Brown County County Court, and effective January 1, 2003, the Morrow County County Court.

Designated one of the part-time judges of the Brown County County Court to continue after that court is abolished as the full-time judge of the Brown County Municipal Court from February 9, 2003, until December 31, 2005, and designated the part-time judge of the Morrow County County Court to continue after that court is abolished as the full-time judge of the Morrow County Municipal Court from January 1, 2003, until December 31, 2005.

Continued the authority of the mayors of Georgetown and of Mount Gilead to conduct a mayor's court.

Established one full-time judgeship in the Brown County Municipal Court and in the Morrow County Municipal Court. Provided that the clerk of the Morrow County Municipal Court must be appointed by the court and that the clerk's compensation must be determined by the revenues of the Court and provided that the Brown County clerk of courts must serve as clerk for the Brown County Municipal Court and receive compensation as specified in the bill.
