



*Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

125th General Assembly
(S. Highways & Transportation)

Removes a provision from the bill as passed by the House that would have authorized the Director of Transportation specifically to use white markers with blue letters to designate Interstate Route 75 as the "Pearl Harbor Memorial Highway" and replaces the specified sign coloring with general authority for the Director to erect suitable markers.

Eliminates the current requirement for the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to complete a force account project assessment form before undertaking *maintenance* or *repair* of a state highway, or a bridge or culvert on a state highway, or the maintenance or repair of a traffic control signal on a state highway, while retaining the requirement for ODOT to use the forms before undertaking the *construction, reconstruction* by widening or resurfacing, or *improvement* of a state highway, or a bridge or culvert on a state highway, or the *installation* of a traffic control signal on a state highway.
