



*Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

125th General Assembly
(S. Agriculture)

Precludes a political subdivision from requiring an owner or operator of an animal feeding facility who holds any of several specified permits or certificates or is operating under an approved operation and management plan to obtain a license, permit, or other approval pertaining to manure, insects or rodents, odor, or siting requirements for installation of such a facility.

States that for the purpose of issuance of a review compliance certificate, an existing concentrated animal feeding facility's manure management plan that does not conform with best management practices regarding manure management temporarily must be deemed by the Director of Agriculture to conform with those practices if the owner or operator of the facility takes specified actions.
