



## *Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments\**

### **Sub. H.B. 223**

125th General Assembly  
(S. Insurance, Commerce, and Labor)

Removes from the House-passed version a requirement that within 60 days after the bill's effective date, employers send a letter to their employees or include an enclosure with employee paychecks explaining that testing positive for alcohol or drugs or refusing to be tested may affect their eligibility for workers' compensation benefits, and removes the related requirement that for each employee hired after the bill's effective date, employers must supply similar written notice as a part of an employee's orientation process.
