



*Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

125th General Assembly
(S. Health, Human Services and Aging)

Makes establishment of a drug database by the State Board of Pharmacy permissive, rather than mandatory as provided in the House version of the bill.

Qualifies the House-created authority of the Board to provide information from the drug database to a law enforcement officer, regulatory body, or grand jury, by specifying that the Board may provide information that is related to a person who is the subject of an investigation.

Adds a provision allowing the Board to release information in summary, statistical, or aggregate form.

Makes conforming changes in the House version's provisions dealing with the Board's duty to adopt rules for operating the drug database.
