



*Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

The committee adopted amendments that do the following:

(1) Specify that the county probation department collects a DNA specimen from a juvenile when the juvenile is not committed to the Department of Youth Services or other specified facilities;

(2) Provide that a person who refuses to submit to a DNA specimen collection procedure may be subject to the law regarding the arrest of a parolee or other releasee for certain specified violations;

(3) Allow the Director of Rehabilitation and Correction to prescribe rules to collect a DNA specimen from an offender whose supervision is transferred from another state to this state in accordance with the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision.
