



## *Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*\*

### **Sub. S.B. 179**

125th General Assembly

(H. Homeland Security, Engineering, and Architectural Design Committee)

#### **Licensure of felons**

Remove Senate passed change that permitted granting of a license to a person whose felony conviction was more than five years old and returns the language to existing law, which prohibits the licensure of persons convicted of a felony or crime of moral turpitude at anytime. (Sec. 4740.06(B)(5).)

#### **Fees**

Removes the additional authority given in the Senate passed version to the administrative section of the Ohio Construction Industry Licensing Board to establish fees instead of the trade sections and that would no longer require Controlling Board approval of fee increases, returning the language to existing law under which the trade sections establish fees with Controlling Board approval. (Sec. 4740.09.)
