(Senate Judiciary)

The Senate Judiciary committee adopted an amendment that removes from the bill the prohibition against an officer or other person charged with a duty in selecting or summoning jurors excluding or failing to summon a citizen for jury duty on account of race, national origin, gender, age, religious belief, income, occupation, disability, or any other factor that forms the basis of a cognizable group of citizens and instead prohibits an officer or other person charged with a duty in *compiling the jury source list or the annual jury list* from excluding or failing to summon a citizen for jury duty on account of race or color.
