Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

The Senate Judiciary Civil Justice Committee adopted amendments to do the following:

1. Raise from 75 to 76 the age at which a person cannot assume judicial office pursuant to election or appointment.
2. Prohibit a person from being elected or appointed to any judicial office if that person is 71 years of age or older during the person's term of office as a judge of the Supreme Court or the court of appeals and is that age on or prior to November 8, 2011.
3. Make a technical correction.
