Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*

The Committee made the following changes to the Senate-passed version of the bill:

(1) It added a requirement that a person who enters or remains on certain abandoned land, blighted parcels, or places of public amusement that are similar in nature to remediate it enter or remain on the land or parcel during the daylight hours from sunrise to sunset.

(2) It modified the affirmative defense to the offense of "criminal trespass" to provide that the person charged entered or remained on the land or parcel described in (1) above during the daylight hours between sunrise and sunset.

(3) It provided that the immunity granted to a landowner for a person who enters or remains on such land or parcel does not apply in regard to injury, death, or loss to person or property of a trespasser to the extent that R.C. 2305.402 (duties of landowner to trespasser) provides for or governs civil liability with respect to the injury, death, or loss.
