Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*

The Committee made the following changes to the bill as passed by the Senate:

(1) It modified existing law by removing the personal liability of a probate judge for the default, malfeasance, or nonfeasance of an employee appointed by the judge and removing language that made a probate judge's liability for such acts contingent on whether the judge required the appointee to give a bond.

(2) It modified existing law by removing the personal liability of a juvenile judge for the default, malfeasance, or nonfeasance of an employee appointed by the judge and removing language that made a juvenile judge's liability for such acts contingent on whether the judge required the appointee to give a bond.

(3) It renamed the Medicaid estate recovery reporting form the Medicaid estate recovery notice form and eliminated the requirement for the administrator of the Medicaid estate recovery program to prescribe a reporting form and the requirement for the probate court to send a copy of the completed probate form to the administrator of the program.

(4) It removed the provisions specifying the contents of the reporting form, which include a listing of the decedent's property and assets that are part of the estate and a statement informing the person responsible for the estate that knowingly making a false statement on the form is the offense of falsification.
