Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*

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Sub. S.B. 139

129th General Assembly
(H. Commerce, Labor and Technology)

Requires a professional employer organization (PEO) to be eligible to use any small business allowance or exemption based on the PEO's employees who are not shared employees with a client employer, rather than to be eligible to use any small business allowance or exemption that is available to the client employer for the shared employees under the As Passed version.

Delays to April 1, 2013, from January 1, 2012, in the As Passed version, the effective date for complying with the bill's registration and financial requirements, including registration as a PEO reporting entity, the prohibition against unrelated PEOs joining together, the authority of the Administrator of Workers' Compensation to issue limited registration, the provision that makes confidential specified information the Administrator obtains, and the Administrator's duty to maintain a list of registered PEOs and PEO reporting entities.

Requires the bond, letter of credit, or security required under the bill for a PEO reporting entity to be held by a depository designated by the Administrator of Workers' Compensation and requires the bond, letter of credit, or security to secure payment of the same items that a bond, letter of credit, or security of a PEO must secure under the As Passed version.
