Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*

The House Committee adopted amendments to the Senate-passed version of the bill to do the following:

Eliminate a requirement that the offender know or have reasonable cause to know that the victim is an elderly person or disabled adult for the offender to be guilty of "telecommunications fraud perpetrated against an elderly person or disabled adult."

Specify that a subpoena or subpoena duces tecum issued by the Attorney General to a provider of remote computing services is subject to the limitations set forth in the "Electronic Communications Privacy Act of 1986."
