State Board of Pharmacy disciplinary actions

Removes a Senate provision that would have authorized the State Board of Pharmacy to take disciplinary action against a pharmacist who fails to practice in accordance with acceptable and prevailing standards for the practice of pharmacy.

State Dental Board disciplinary actions

Removes a Senate provision that would have authorized the State Dental Board to take professional disciplinary action for making a false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statement in soliciting or advertising for patients or in relation to the practice of dentistry, and restores the Board's existing authority to take disciplinary action for advertising in a false or misleading manner or violating the Board's rules on advertising.

Access to information in the Ohio Automated Rx Reporting System (OARRS)

Adds a provision authorizing a prescriber to review OARRS information regarding a potential patient based on a referral of the patient to the prescriber.

Carisoprodol

Eliminates a reference in current law to a pain management clinic's treatment of pain with carisoprodol—a muscle relaxant and pain relieving drug that according to the Pharmacy Board is now classified as a controlled substance and, therefore, no longer needs to be separately specified.
