Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

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Sub. H.B. 1

130th General Assembly
(S. Workforce and Economic Development)

Requires each one-stop system to include at least one representative from a county department of job and family services.

Allows a board of county commissioners to appoint an advisory committee on workforce development and lists the activities in which the committee may engage.

Restores the current law distribution list for the State Board's annual Ohio workforce report.

Expands the proposed definition of OhioMeansJobs, the proposed requirement that OhioMeansJobs system be used by all local areas, and the proposed prohibition against duplicative systems in the House-passed version to include that the system is used for labor exchange activity as well as job placement activity.
