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## Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments\*

### **Sub. H.B. 165**

130th General Assembly  
(S. Commerce and Labor)

Adds two additional requirements to the House-passed version that a person must satisfy to qualify for the bill's exemption from the laws governing the practice of respiratory care: (1) the person must file with the Respiratory Care Board a copy of the person's current certification as a certified hyperbaric technologist in accordance with rules adopted by the Board, and (2) the person must pay a filing fee, established by the Board, not to exceed \$20.

Adds advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants to the House-passed version list of individuals under whose direct supervision a person may perform hyperbaric oxygen therapy to qualify for the bill's exemption.
