Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

130th General Assembly
(S. Medicaid, Health and Human Services)

Removes provisions that would have specifically authorized first responders and emergency medical technicians-basic to administer naloxone.

Requires wholesale and certain terminal distributors of dangerous drugs that supply naloxone to prioritize the sale, distribution, and delivery of that drug to hospitals, children's hospitals, emergency medical service organizations, and urgent care centers.

Permits certain clinical nurse specialists, certified nurse-midwives, and certified nurse practitioners that have prescriptive authority in another jurisdiction to take the required schedule II controlled substance training through an Internet-based course of study, rather than through planned classroom and clinical instruction.
