## Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments\*

### **Am. Sub. H.B. 178** 130th General Assembly (S. Education)

Adds a requirement that the State Board of Education must adopt rules establishing a policy and standards for the implementation of positive behavior intervention supports and the use of physical restraint or seclusion on students.

Adds a provision specifying that each school district, community school, science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) school, and college preparatory boarding school must comply with the policies and standards adopted by the State Board.

Qualifies any private school located within the boundaries of a school district adjacent to the pilot project school district (Cleveland), in addition to any private school located within the boundaries of the pilot project school district, for the Pilot Project Scholarship Program as under current law.

Replaces the term "school safety plan" with "emergency management plan" in accordance with amendments enacted in Am. Sub. H.B. 487 of the 130th General Assembly.

Qualifies a private school that is located within the boundaries of a school district that is adjacent to the Cleveland Municipal School District to enroll students under the Cleveland Pilot Project Scholarship.

Makes an appropriation for the Old Fort Local School District's costs related to the transfer of the Bettsville Local School District.
