Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

The Senate Civil Justice committee adopted amendments that do the following:

1. Remove the requirement that an affidavit for a proceeding for a mentally ill person subject to court order be filed in the probate court in the county where the mentally ill person subject to court order resides, therefore allowing the affidavit to be filed with a probate court in any county.
2. Allow a notary public to sign an affidavit for a proceeding for a mentally ill person subject to court order.
3. Remove the provision that specified that the immunity from civil liability for owning, managing, or having responsibility for a premises or location where an automated external defibrillator has been placed applies only if reasonable efforts have been undertaken to maintain the defibrillator according to the manufacturer's guidelines.
