## Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments\*

### **Am. H.B. 326**

130th General Assembly  
(S. Commerce and Labor)

Exempts the following individuals from the requirement to be licensed by the State Board of Orthotics, Prosthetics, and Pedorthics in order to practice orthotics, prosthetics, and pedorthics, if the individual is acting within the applicable scope of practice: a licensed pharmacist, licensed pharmacist intern, registered wholesale distributor of dangerous drugs, or licensed terminal distributor of dangerous drugs.

Removes the House-passed proposed exemption for diabetic shoe fitters who complete specified training from the requirement to be licensed by the Board.
