### **Sub. H.B. 440**

130th General Assembly  
(S. Transportation)

Designates the following on specified portions of roadways and highways and on specified bridges:

- (1) "Captain Everett 'Butch' Keaton, Vietnam, SSM and BSM with OLC PH, Memorial Highway" in Pike County;
- (2) "Staff Sergeant Wesley Williams Memorial Highway" in Clark County;
- (3) "Captain Dennis Pintor Memorial Highway" in Allen County;
- (4) "U.S.M.C. LCpl. Daniel G. Zegarac Memorial Highway" in the city of Kirtland;
- (5) "Chief Petty Officer Raymond Border Memorial Highway" in Coshocton County;
- (6) "Trooper Charles V. Vogel Memorial Highway" in Clark County;
- (7) "Persian Gulf Veterans Bridge" in Trumbull County;
- (8) "Iraq and Afghanistan Veterans Bridge" in Trumbull County;
- (9) "World War I Veterans Highway" in Ashtabula County;
- (10) "Veterans Memorial Highway" in the city of Amsterdam;
- (11) "U.S. Army Specialist Justin Helton Memorial Highway" in Pike County;
- (12) "Marine Sergeant James Prommersberger and Army Second Lieutenant Charles W. Brown Memorial Highway" in Mahoning County;

(13) "LCpl Josh McDaniels Memorial Highway" in Madison and Franklin Counties;

(14) "Specialist Angel L. Lopez Memorial Highway" in the city of Cleveland;

(16) "Cpl. James E. Blevins Memorial Highway" in Jefferson County;

(17) "Army Cpl. Nathan B. Carse Memorial Highway" in Allen County;

(18) "U.S.M.C. Lance Corporal Dustin R. Fitzgerald 'Dusty' Memorial Highway" in the city of Huber Heights;

(19) "U.S. Army Private First Class James P. White, Jr. 'J.P.' Memorial Highway" in the city of Huber Heights;

(20) "Army Spc. Joseph 'Joey' Riley Memorial Highway" in Franklin County;

(21) "Patrolman Carl 'Shorty' Thrush Memorial Highway" in Hocking County;

(22) "Officer Justin Winebrenner Memorial Highway" in Summit County; and

(23) "OSHP Sgt. John F. Best Memorial Highway" in Wyandot County.

Modifies the location of the existing "Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree Memorial Road" by extending it into Summit County rather than locating it solely in Stark County as in current law.
