Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

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Sub. H.B. 511

130th General Assembly
(S. Insurance and Financial Institutions)

Specifies that chemotherapy parity requirements, as they apply to high deductible health plans, apply only after the respective deductible has been met.

Makes a peace officer, firefighter, or emergency medical worker who is diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder eligible to receive compensation and benefits under Ohio's Workers' Compensation Law under certain circumstances, regardless of whether the individual suffers an accompanying physical injury.

Delays the application of the changes relating to insurance coverage for dependent children and eligible employees under small employer benefit plans to plans delivered or renewed on or after January 1, 2016 (from January 1, 2015).
