Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*

(H. Agriculture & Natural Resources and H. Finance and Appropriations)

Potentially expands the application of the provisions of the Agricultural Additives, Lime, and Fertilizer Law governing fertilizer by revising the bill's definition of "agricultural production" to mean the cultivation, primarily for sale, of plants or any parts of plants on more than 50 acres, rather than 50 contiguous acres as in the Senate-passed version, excluding the use of start-up fertilizer applied through a planter.

Requires money in the continuing Conservation Reserve Management Program that is not retained by soil and water conservation districts for certain activities related to nutrient reduction in Lake Erie to be transferred to the Healthy Lake Erie Fund created by the bill rather than to the GRF as in the Senate-passed version.
