## Synopsis of House Committee Amendments\*

### **Sub. S.B. 173**

130th General Assembly  
(H. Policy & Legislative Oversight)

Expands the locations that qualify for a D-8 liquor permit (authorizes the sale of tasting samples of specified alcoholic beverages) to include a retail store to which all of the following apply:

--It has been issued a liquor permit authorizing retail sale of beer, wine, and mixed beverages for off-premises consumption (a C-1, C-2, or C-2x liquor permit);

--It has at least 4,500 square feet of floor area;

--It is located in a municipal corporation or township with a population of 5,000 or less; and

--It generates 60% of its sales in nonalcohol related items.

Allows an F-6 liquor permit (authorizes the auction of wine at a special event for the benefit of a nonprofit corporation) to be issued for the same location as an F-8 liquor permit (allows alcohol sales at special events held on public property).

Prohibits an F-6 and F-8 permit from being exercised concurrently at the same location.
