Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*

Changes, from April 1, 2014 to January 1, 2015, the date on which an auditing entity is subject to conditions concerning (1) notice to the pharmacy being audited, (2) audit time limits, (3) amounts that may be recouped, and (4) use of the accounting practice of extrapolation.

Adds a provision that allows an optometrist to continue to employ, apply, administer, or prescribe an analgesic drug that immediately before the bill's effective date is in the narcotics-narcotic preparations category of schedule III controlled substances, even if the drug is subsequently transferred to a different schedule or category by the General Assembly, by rule of the State Board of Pharmacy, or under the federal drug abuse control laws.

Makes two technical changes to correct typographical errors.
