Requires the state agency that employs an officer or employee who actively advocates in a fiduciary capacity as a representative of that agency to pay the officer's or employee's registration fee as a legislative agent. Fiscal effect: Increases revenues to the Joint Legislative Ethics Committee Investigative Fund and decreases revenues to the GRF. Payment of registration fees for state employees will likely increase revenues of the Joint Legislative Ethics Committee Fund.

No provision.	<div>R.C. 103.24</div> <div>Codifies Fund 5E30, the House and Senate Telephone Usage Fund, created by the Controlling Board and renames it the Legislative Agency Telephone Usage Fund. Broadens the use of the fund to include the Joint Legislative Ethics Committee and any other legislative agency as determined by LSC.</div> <div>Fiscal effect: May increase the revenues and expenditures of the fund.</div>
