Requires the BWC Board of Directors Nominating Committee to submit a list of potential replacements to fill a vacancy on the Board to the Governor at least 30 days before the vacancy occurs, rather than within 60 days after the vacancy occurs as currently required by law.

R.C. *4121.12*

Same as the Executive, but specifies that if the Governor appoints an individual to fill a vacancy that is the result of a term expiration, the newly appointed individual will begin service as a Board member when the term for which the individual's predecessor was appointed expires or immediately upon appointment by the Governor, which ever occurs later.
