Requires the BWC Board of Directors Nominating Committee to submit a list of potential replacements to fill a vacancy on the Board to the Governor at least 30 days before the vacancy occurs, rather than within 60 days after the vacancy occurs as currently required by law. Same as the Executive, but specifies that if the Governor appoints an individual to fill a vacancy that is the result of a term expiration, the newly appointed individual will begin service as a Board member when the term for which the individual's predecessor was appointed expires or immediately upon appointment by the Governor, which ever occurs later.
