Activities undertaken with these funds include spillway repairs, lake drain repairs, drainage improvements, and emergency repairs due to flooding or other sudden changes to a dam's condition.

They involve: (1) replacement of 60-year old, single-pane windows and frames, (2) replacement of the current, 35-year old boiler system heating the OSB pool (used as part of the school's adaptive physical education program) with an energy efficient hot water heating system, (3) for the lower level of the old OSB school building, removal of asbestos-laden vinyl composition tiles (VCTs) and asbestos-laden mastic glue, installation of new VCT flooring, and radon remediation, (4) remodeling portions of the old OSB school building to provide office and work spaces for various OSB departments that will need to relocate due to the closing off and mothballing of the primary wing of the school building, (5) installation of fire lanes around existing OSB buildings to ensure emergency vehicles have sufficient access to all buildings on the campus, and (6) production of a feasibility study to plan for the future demolition of certain existing buildings on the OSB campus, many of which share common electrical, HVAC, fire, telecommunications, and utilities systems or infrastructure.

This appropriation will fund program years 26 and 27 of the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP), which provides low-interest loans and grants to local governments for projects involving roads and bridges, fresh water treatment and distribution systems, wastewater collection and treatment facilities, storm sewer systems, and solid waste disposal facilities. The State Capital Improvements Fund (Fund 7038) receives approximately \$150 million in bond proceeds each year, with debt service paid from the GRF. All repayments of loans made under SCIP are deposited into the Revolving Loan Fund (Fund 7040).
