BWCCD14 Renaming BWC as the Ohio Department of Workforce Insurance and Safety

R.C. 4121.121, 4121.12, 4121.123, 4121.129, and numerous other sections in Chapters 4121., 4123., and others; Sections 610.10, and 741.10

Changes the name of the Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) to the Department of Workforce Insurance and Safety (ODWIS). Provides that the duties and responsibility under BWC continue under ODWIS. Makes conforming changes to the names of the various offices, boards, and committees overseeing the workers' compensation system.

Fiscal effect: ODWIS will incur one-time costs to update signs, materials, and its website to reflect the new name.

Requires the TOS to remit up to \$25,000,000 cash in each fiscal year from the SIF to the Workers' Compensation Fund (Fund 7023).

BWCCD12 Deputy Inspector General for the Worker's Compensation System Funding

Section: 200.20 Section: 200.20

Requires the OBM Director to transfer \$425,000 cash every six months of the biennium from Fund 7023 to the Deputy Inspector General for the Workers' Compensation System Fund (Fund 5FT0) for the costs related to the Deputy Inspector General for the Workers' Compensation System.

Specifies that if additional amounts are needed, the Inspector General may seek Controlling Board approval for additional transfers of cash and to increase the amount appropriated in ALI 965604, Deputy Inspector General for the Bureau of Workers' Compensation and Ohio Industrial Commission.
