## OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL

 Expands the qualifications for appointment as Inspector General or deputy Inspector General to include individuals with at least five years of experience as a deputy Inspector General in Ohio or any other state.

## **Deputy Inspector General qualifications**

(R.C. 121.49)

The act expands the qualifications to become Inspector General or a deputy Inspector General in Ohio. It permits an individual with at least five years of experience as a deputy inspector general in Ohio or another state to become Inspector General, and permits an individual with at least five years of experience as a deputy Inspector General in another state to become a deputy inspector general in Ohio. Continuing law requires deputy Inspector Generals of transportation and workers compensation to meet the same qualifications as the Inspector General.<sup>89</sup>
