Purpose: This line item is used to pay the Chemical Dependency Professionals Board's

operating expenses, including personal services, supplies, maintenance, and equipment. The Board regulates the practice of chemical dependency prevention and treatment and in June 2004, began issuing licenses and certifications for

chemical dependency professionals. (Prior to 2004, the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services was responsible for issuing licenses and certificates for chemical dependency professionals.) The Board also sets standards of practice, investigates complaints, determines appropriate disciplinary actions, and monitors

continuing education compliance.
